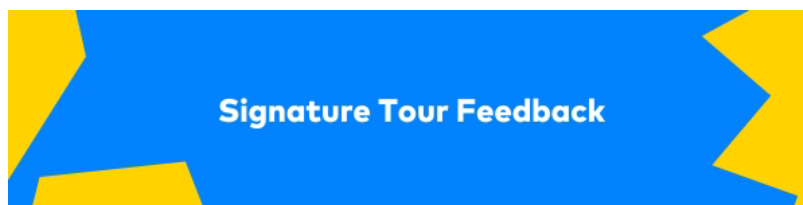

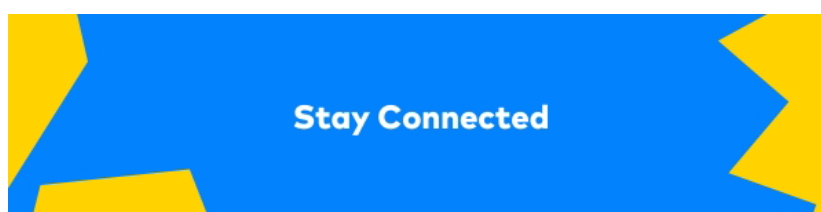

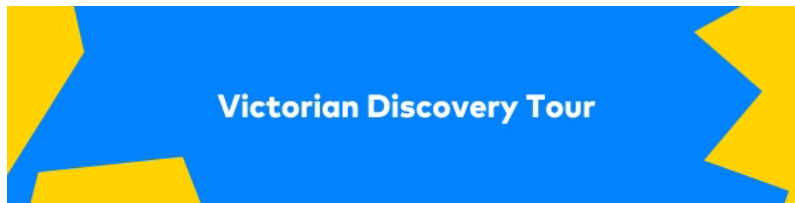
Lost Property

We will share a photo in WhatsApp of all the lost property left over from Sig Tour when the truck returns from SA Tour.

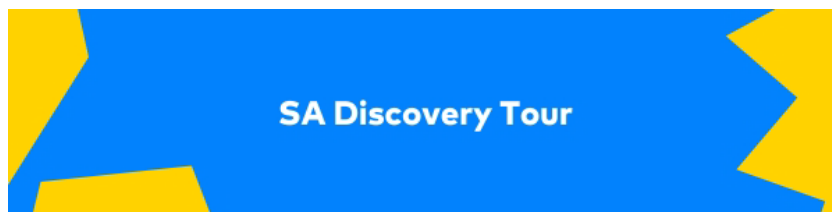
